What is the Junior Ladies of Charity?

Founded in France in 1909, in the spirit of St. Vincent de Paul and St. Louise de Marillac, the Junior Ladies of Charity is a volunteer



organization of young women who engage in Christian service to the poor on behalf of the Association of the Ladies of Charity.



Who are the Junior Ladies of Charity?

The Junior Ladies of Charity are young women, elementary through college age, who promote and support the Vincentian Spirit.

Their mission is to recognize the face of Christ in the poor by identifying and responding to the needs of the poor in their own communities.

Where are the Junior Ladies of Charity?

Junior LOC are associated with Catholic Schools or Diocesan/Parish groups sponsored through a local Ladies of Charity Association.

Currently, in the United States, there are more than 19 Junior LOC chapters with over 780 young women enrolled.



What do the Junior Ladies of Charity do?

Junior activities are unlimited! They are based on the needs that Juniors identify and their own interests!

- Fundraise through bake sales, BBQs, car washes, ticket sales, raffles, bingo, etc.
- Visit the elderly and sick
- Serve at shelters
- Staff food pantries, thrift shops and garage sales
- Mentor/tutor disadvantaged
- Disaster relief
- Parish support: youth formation, music ministry, Eucharistic ministry, lector, altar services, grounds keeping
