Departs from hotel at 4:44am for a 5:25am arrival at the airport, Departs from hotel every 14 minutes & 44 minutes after the hour until 6:14pm. For departure times after 6:14 pm, reservations are required. Contact KCI a minimum of 3 hours in advance. The Hyatt bell stand can help with getting in contact with KCI Super Shuttle for departures if needed.

**KCI Airport:** Take I-29 south from the airport to U.S. 169 South/Downtown Exit. Take 169 South over the bridge and proceed onto Broadway. Turn left on 20<sup>th</sup> street. Follow 20<sup>th</sup> Street to McGee Street and make a right on McGee. Hyatt is on the left.

**I-70 East Bound:** Follow I-70 East to I-670 East. Continue on I-670 East to I-35 North; then take the Broadway Exit (2A). Follow Broadway to 20<sup>th</sup> Street and make a left. Follow 20<sup>th</sup> street to McGee Street and take a right onto McGee. The Hyatt is on the left.

**I-70 West Bound:** Follow I-70 West to the I-35 South Exit. Follow I-35 south to the Broadway Exit (2A). Follow Broadway to 20<sup>th</sup> Street and make a left. Follow 20<sup>th</sup> street to McGee Street and take a right onto McGee. The Hyatt is on the left.

**I-35 South Bound:** Follow I-35 south to the Broadway Exit (2A). Follow Broadway to 20<sup>th</sup> Street and make a left. Follow 20<sup>th</sup> street to McGee Street and take a right onto McGee. The Hyatt is on the left.

This tour will culminate in a guided walk-through of the nationally-recognized Liberty Memorial World War I Museum. Designated by Congress as the Official World War I Museum, this site presents a comprehensive interpretation of the first World War (1914-1919) and its lasting consequences.
