
# **CALLED to SERVICE** – Louise de Marillac

**Call to Prayer:** Louise writes to Vincent: "... this is the opportune time to work for the establishment of the Confraternity of Charity ... Ladies who show the greatest desire for this holy work need to gather together, both from the nobility and from the lower class, [to] give themselves willingly to the poor ... I am telling you all this, Monsieur, so as to save time. These good women have been trying to encourage one another. We must strike while the iron is hot. ..."

(1 Peter 4: 10 English Standard Version)

**Reader 1:** "Whoever is generous to the poor lends to the Lord, and God will repay her for this deed." (PAUSE briefly.) (Proverbs 19: 17 ESV)

Reader 2: "Only fear the LORD and serve him faithfully with all your heart." (PAUSE) (1 Samuel 12: 24 ESV)

**Reader 3:** "If anyone would be first, he must be last of all and servant of all." (PAUSE) (Mark 9: 35 ESV)

**Reader 4:** "... through love serve one another. For the whole law is fulfilled in ... "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." (PAUSE) (Galatians 5: 13-14 ESV)

## Personal Reflection and Sharing


What gifts have I received from God that I am called to share with others? How is God inviting me to give myself in service at home, as a Lady of Charity, this year?
