**Response:** We commit ourselves to pay attention to the people today who are living on the margins of society and their needs.

We believe that, You, Who know each of us by Name, will help us sail into the open waters of a future yet unknown.

**Response:** We trust that You are our Navigator, Loving Jesus, who steer us through the crashing waves of violence, discrimination, and societally imposed suffering of so many people we are called to serve.
