Rev. Guillermo Campuzano, CM, International Vincentian Family Office

Keynote Speaker

Fr. Campuzano (also known as Fr. Memo) is a Vincentian Missionary and member of the Western Province of the Congregation of the Mission, USA. He was ordained a priest for the service of the poor on December 8, 1993. Over his 33 years of ministry, he has held numerous leadership and formation roles in priestly formation, consecrated life, and lay ministry. He was recently appointed to the International Office of the Vincentian Family, where he serves the Global South. Father Guillermo worked at the United Nations for five years and served as Vice President of DePaul University in Chicago until January 2024.
